2.	Disclosures of Interests	SW's employer hosts the domain for www.moulsoeparish.org. NR is Parish Council representative MCA
3.	Minutes of the Last Meeting	The minutes of the meeting on Tuesday 10 September with the following amendment, <i>Item 1909/6.3 The Parish Council want to make it clear that their intention is not to restrict the marketability of the hall, were signed as a correct record by SW.</i>

5.	Ward Councillors' Update	<b>HIF bid</b> – there will be no updates on this until after the General Election <b>New Prospective Conservative MP</b> - Mark Lancaster will not be standing for re-election Councillor Ben Everitt will be standing as MK North Conservative Candidate. <b>Marshall's Aerospace</b> – this is a development that Ward Councillors will monitor. It will be a Bedfordshire Council planning matter, but Moulsoe Parish Council will be consulted in the planning process should the development move forward. It will cause an increase of traffic through the village and air noise. Traffic management will need to be addressed and S106 funding from any development should be made available to be used in the village.
6.	Costain Galliford Try	The liaison officer did not attend the meeting. The continuing muddy state of the road at the site entrance is a concern. The road sweeper is now cleaning the road on a more regular basis, but as the site is likely to be in operation for a further 18 months the council opinion is that more needs to be done to keep the road clean for all users of Newport Road. 7.	Parish Council Business	
7.1	Defibrillator	The protocol for access to the code previously agreed by the Council was signed. Clerk will organise for representatives from MCA and Dodman Inns to sign the document. The code is only to be used after 999 has been called. South Central Ambulance have confirmed all details on their systems are correct and that should the call require a defibrillator then the code would be given. Clerk has replaced the electrode pads that were due to expire in January, and the unit is in full working order. Council <b>AGREED</b> that a refresher course would be beneficial not only to staff at the Carrington Arms but to the village, this to be organised for early 2020.
7.2	Traffic & Roads	<b>Newport Road/A509</b> – as discussed in item 6 <b>Sentinel</b> – TVP have ordered a device. Lucy Boddington has been seconded to other duties so SW will speak to her successor for any updates <b>ANPR</b> – TVP have been told of our decision to go ahead with the investment of ANPR there is no further news on the progress.
7.3	Marshall Aerospace	SW & JH attended the recent information evening in Cranfield hosted by Marshall Aerospace,
7.4	MCA	The parish council had received the MCA response to the council's decision to not allow the field to be used as overflow parking. Council agreed to meet with the MCA; a provisional date 25 November was agreed. NR to confirm with the other members of the MCA. ( <i>Post meeting note – Joint meeting 2 December</i> )

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7.5	Cranfield Road Parking	<p>A resident had been in contact with a concern over the new parking conditions being set by People for Places, and the suggested parking enforcement.</p> <p>The parking area concerned is not MK Council adopted highway, so People for Places are able to implement conditions. Residents should not be fined if parked on MK Council adopted highways. The areas of adopted highways can be seen via my mapping resource on the Milton Keynes Council website. SW will reply to the resident.</p>	
7.6	Playing Field	<p>Following on from concerns from a resident that dogs were on the field and suggestions that new signage may be required, Clerk provided examples of alternative signs. Council <b>AGREED</b> to the purchase of 2 new signs. Clerk to order.</p>
