2. **Disclosures of Interests:** SW employer hosts the domain for the village website.

5. **Police Report:** PCSO Ormston is back in the office and will hopefully be out in the area soon.  
This month Rural Team are promoting the national database Immobilise.com.uk. Can be used to register their possessions, all police areas can access the database to recover lost/stolen items.  
Clerk to add a PCSO page to website so all reports can be put in one place for residents to be informed.
6. **Ward Councillor's Report:** MK Council has the draft budget out for consultation until 31 January 2022. Council tax proposed rise of 1.99%.  
Ward Councillor budget is available, Clerk has forwarded details to St. Mary's and the Millennium Hall committee.
7. **Parish Council Business & Matters Arising from Last Minutes:**
  - 7.1 **MK East** – The parish council has been made aware of other parties that are taking advice into options available to them to challenge the legalities of the decision making leading to the granting of the planning permission in November.
  - 7.2 **Planning Applications:**  
**Bloor Homes 21/03420/OUTEIS** – Objection to the application and comments will be submitted by to MK Planning by 21 January 2022.  
**Diversion of Moulsoe Footpath 14** – Diversion necessary due to the new road layout of the MK East development. Council have no comments to make on the diversion, Clerk to inform Rights of Way Officer.

**7.3 Community Speed Watch:** Clerk had attended a meeting with MKC Road Safety Officer Keith Wheeler. Parishes are encouraged to join new Speed watch scheme with all data submitted being viewed by TVP and any consistent speeding issues have the potential to be escalated within TVP. No equipment will be available from MKC and suggested that parishes purchase their own. Training is now online. TVP have a dedicated Community Speed Watch coordinator.

**SIDS:** All SIDs are to be returned to Keith Wheeler for audit and maintenance. SIDs no longer to be held by hubs and will be on loan to parishes on a monthly basis. Bids for funding for purchasing parish owned SIDs can be made to the Community Infrastructure Fund.

**8. Parish Councillor Reports:** SW & COH have met with BP pulse in connection with installing EV charging points in the village. BP have indicated that the only suitable location would be adjacent to the phone kiosk. BP will be discussing the site and suitability with MK Highways.
