

8.2. Traffic & Roads: VAS sign- Clerk to contact Highways to request that the sign be removed as it no longer works and MKC no longer have the budget to maintain it.

Parking Issues: There were no further updates.

Road Closures: they have an impact on those in the village that rely on the bus service.

It had been noted that at certain points in the village visibility is reduced due to lack of hedge cutting.

Concern that construction traffic turning right at the A509 junction. To be raised at next meeting with St. James.

8.3. Footpaths: Clerk had received queries from residents on the diversions and the lack of signage on the routes. Rights of Way officer had been contacted and had confirmed to the Clerk that maps would be placed on the recently erected signs. It was a legal duty that the notice of closure and diversion were displayed before the maps were put in place. NR had also spoken to the team on site and they were awaiting the maps from MKC.

Noticeboard at Broughton Grounds – Clerk had received an email from the local Ramblers representative as the board had fallen/been knocked down and as it was on Moulsoe Parish land it was assumed it was a parish council owned board, it was put up by local farmers so not the responsibility of the council.

8.4. Marshall Aerospace: SW and Clerk due to meet with Marshall to be updated on the recent exhibition in Cranfield. Marshall have no plans to send out information to residents and advised that all the information on the relocation can be found on their website.

8.5. Jubilee: MCA had received little interest from their recent flyer. There will be a lighting of a beacon within the parish on the evening of Thursday 2nd June. On the morning of 2nd June the church will be raising a flag on the new flagpole that has been purchased with funds from the Ward Councillors fund and the balance being met by the Carrington Arms. All timings and details will be distributed to the village in due course.
