

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (VARIOUS ROADS MOULSOE AND CASTLETHORPE) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes intends, in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. in order to enable Anglian Water to carry out new connection works from **18th July 2022 – 5th August 2022 (24 Hours)**.

The effect of the above Order will be to temporarily close part of:

London Road, Moulsoe – From its junction with A422 for approximately 488 meters southern direction.

Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route will be via London Road, A509, Tongwell Street and Willen Road (and vice versa).

Signs will be erected in advance of the closure to inform members of the public of the forthcoming closure.

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order for Anglian Water will come into effect on 5th July 2022 and remain in effect for a period of 3 month and will take effect at times during the above period only when works are required and only when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties and Residents.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the TSRGD 2016 (The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016). All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to the works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
