Milton Keynes City Council (MKCC) passed the budget for 2026-27 and as expected there is a 4.99% increase in council tax. Both Councillor McLean and Councillor Geary voted against the budget that included an increase in Councillor expenses. There continues to be litter on the verges, Councillor McLean has requested that MKCC Highways and Waste and Recycling departments provide Ward Councillors with a cleansing schedule, to assist them in monitoring the situation.
With local elections on 7th May there is still time to apply for a postal vote.
Potholes, continue to be an issue, Cllr. McLean is expecting an update from Highways with a schedule of planned roadworks within Milton Keynes.
Council raised the lack of communication regarding closures and the state of the road particularly Newport Road.
As this was the last meeting for Ward Councillors before the elections the parish council thanked them for all their support and advice over the years they have been our Ward Councillors.

New residents are moving into Ouzelmere, and Elverby Primary School is now advertising spaces for reception spaces.

Clerk has reported the antisocial behaviour of speeding vehicles on the new road layout to Thames Valley Police (TVP) and it is hoped that residents will also report any incidents.

PLN/2026/0019 - Outline application for the erection of one 3-bedroom dwelling for self-build on land at PARK VIEW, CRANFIELD ROAD, MOULSOE, NEWPORT PAGNELL, MK16 0HL

Council objected to the previous application on the grounds of access to highway at the narrowest point of the village and the overdevelopment of the site. MKCC Highways also lodged an objection regarding the depiction of the splays on to the road. Council still has concerns over the access and lack of parking for visitors to the properties and will put these concerns to MKCC planning department.

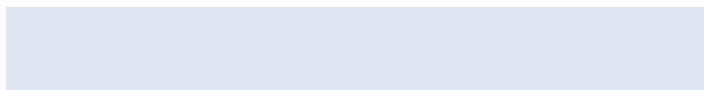

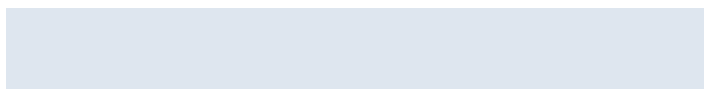
