



Minutes for the meeting of MOULSOE PARISH COUNCIL held on
Tuesday 14 July 2026 at 8 pm, Moulsoe Millennium Hall, Moulsoe

2607/1 To receive apologies for absence:

2607/2 Disclosures of Interests:

SMW employer hosts the domain for the parish website.

2607/3 Approval of Minutes:

Council approved the minutes of the meeting on Tuesday 19 May 2026. SMW signed.

2607/4 To consider application received for co-option to fill vacancy for office of parish councillor:

Councillors received the application for councillor. Applicant proposed by JH and seconded by SL

2607/5 To vote and co-opt applicant to the office of parish councillor:

Council voted unanimously to co-opt GM to the office of parish councillor. GM signed the Declaration of Office in the presence of the Clerk.

2607/6 Police Report:

PCSO Ormston presented the Crime Statistics as attached. Discussion on the anti-social behaviour from vehicles using the new road layouts late at night. Reports are being made, and council and residents are urged to continue to report the speeding, danger to other road users and harassment the activity causes.

2607/7 Ward Councillor's Report:

Ward Councillor Crooks report included information regarding:

MK East Health Centre: opening arrangements are still unresolved; early children's provision may begin in autumn, with first medical services possibly from April 2027, but not yet confirmed.

- Elverby School: plans are firmer, with opening expected in September 2027 for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.
- He will be meeting with Berkeley Homes in August and will be discussing the issues raised at the recent stakeholders meeting.
- Keeper's Place: decision target date has been moved from July to November. Central Bedfordshire Council and Milton Keynes City Council highways departments reports on the proposed development criticised the plans. With the development not included in the MK City Plan to 2037, it would be classed as a speculative development.

2607/8 Parish Council Business:

2607/8.1 Publishing of Information:

The parish council requested they have prior notification of information being sent out by Ward Councillors that relate parish council matters and the parish.

2607/8.2 MK East:

Parish councillors and Clerk had attended the most recent stakeholder meeting. Berkeley will be publishing their newsletter in the Phonebox and were currently speaking with the publisher with the aim to have that delivered to Moulsoe. KW had also spoken to the Phonebox and they indicated that they would be able to deliver to the village, but they would need to find someone to do that. The team at Berkeley are aware that they may need to find an alternative to ensure that all residents in the parish receive the newsletter.

Clerk had received information that the new bus stops within the Milton Keynes East development are being registered in the NaPTAN database, enabling bus operators to register services. Further details on operators, routes and start dates will be confirmed later.

There is a delay in the start of the roadworks on the A509 in connection with the development, the proposed start has now been pushed back to end of August.

There will be some overnight closures required and at other times there will be traffic management in place.

2607/8.3 Traffic and Roads:

Council had received updated drawings for the Traffic Calming Scheme from Milton Keynes City Council (MKCC) Road Safety team. Council is waiting for 2 more revised drawings to enable them to provide feedback to the road safety team.

Options for the scheme will then be part of the consultation process that will be dealt with by MKCC Road Safety Team.

2607/8.4 Planning Applications:

PLN/2026/0382 Far Lawrence – council reviewed the application and had no comments on the plans.

2607/9 Parish Councillor reports:

JH had attended the Parishes Forum with speakers from Haversham-cum-Little Linford Parish Council, Graham Cox Head of MKCC Highways, and John Best from the Canals and River Trust.

SMW had attended the North East Rural Community Forum with speeding and fly-tipping discussed. It was attended by the Chief Inspector.

Councillors had attended the MKCC highways drop-in session. They raised the issue of HGV's blocking the T-junction on Newport Road whilst waiting to enter the MV Kelly compound.

2607/10 Clerks Report:

Council noted the Clerks report that included: Footpath 18: temporary closure notice issued. Actions from the May meeting: insurance updated, highways session attended; request to Bloor for noticeboard at Ouzelmere.

Ongoing issues: Cranfield Road flooding/drains and late-night car racing remain unresolved. Other updates: graffiti was removed from the phone kiosk, website redevelopment was discussed with Aubergine, and the Clerk attended a forum covering City Plan 2050 and Highways Plan 2030.

2607/11.1 KW confirmed the Barclays account balance of £18,718.45.
